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<p>Min:1 Welcome remarks</p> <p>The welcome remarks and introductions were made by Dr. Rosalind. She gave a brief background of the project and explained the purpose of the meeting.</p>	<p><i>Done</i></p>	<p>Dr. Rosalind</p>
<p><u>Min 2: Progress of the exhibition/ feedback</u></p> <p>The Academy program manager shared the progress report of the project to members in line with the project's objectives: The objectives were highlighted as below:</p> <p>1. To establish an exhibition of historical HIV/IEC materials through participatory curation, 2. To evaluate the responses of the participants to HIV materials and 3. To scale up to other sites.</p> <p>She explained all achievements from 1st December to 21st December 2018. Eunice presented the progress on data analysis. (detailed presentation attached)</p> <p>Dr. Kambugu raised an idea of inquiring from the museum whether the exhibition had any impact on the number of their visitors</p> <p>Sylvia communicated that the museum management is happy about the exhibition and is willing to provide space for HIV exhibition in the disease section, so that it can be accessed by other people after closure of the temporary exhibition at the museum.</p> <p>It will be hard to maintain but worth having, and since it will be a small portion of the exhibition, there should be a note referring people to TASO or UAC for more details.</p> <p>It was noted that the messages left at the museum should be carefully chosen to portray messages in the original exhibition.</p>	<p><i>Done</i></p> <p><i>Check the spelling of the ambassadors and the minister's names.</i></p> <p><i>Need to analyze the number of visitors from Kampala and those out of Kampala.</i></p> <p><i>Assess the impact of the exhibition to the museum.eg on numbers, income etc.</i></p> <p><i>Designing a smaller exhibition to be installed at the Uganda museum.</i></p>	<p>Diana</p> <p>Ruth</p> <p>Ruth</p> <p>Curation team</p>
<p>Min 3: Progress on data collection/ analysis</p> <p>Eunice reported on all activities involved in data collection including FGDS, exit and in-depth interviews. <p>Min 4: Discussion on possible next steps for the exhibition (including Health Innovations conference, upcountry visits), plus storage</p> <p>Dr. Rosalind asked the members whether they had suggestions of any group or individuals that should visit the exhibition before it is removed from the museum.</p> <p>Susan from straight talk suggested the minister of tourism to come for this exhibition, since this falls under his ministry.</p> <p>Other members also suggested other people below</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Miss Africa Abenakyo 2. Kyabazinga of Busoga. 3. King of Toro 4. Katikiro Peter Mayega 5. Minister of state for youth, Hon Nakiwala Kiyingi. 6. Senior religious leaders (Sheikh and Mufti) 7. Former USA ambassador who was around during the early days of HIV (Jimmy Kolker) who is coming on 6th February 2019. <p>Members suggested to hold one event for all the above mentioned to go through the exhibition and later have a dialogue with them about funding the next phase of the exhibition. And agreed to extend the exhibition to 11th February 2019 to be able to hold the closing event and also to allow Jimmy Kolker to visit the exhibition on 6th February 2019.</p> <p>Jackie Katana, informed the members that the Ambassador may be happy to support this event and that she will follow up with him about this issue.</p> <p>It was proposed that the invitations for the proposed guests to the exhibition should come from the Embassy of Ireland and follow up would be done by the different team members who had links to these people.</p> <p>There was a need to have a clear objective for this event. Should it be an event for closing phase one and opening phase two? 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<p>be exhibited at the Health Innovations conference in March 2019.</p> <p>It was proposed that the exhibition should be filmed with some voices explaining what it is all about for documentation purposes.</p> <p>There was suggestion of making use of national celebration days and target them for mobile exhibition.</p> <p>The academy was advised to come up with a paragraph to be put in the program of the second phase of the presidential fast track initiative on HIV/AIDS</p> <p>The Embassy of Ireland had tried to get the president to come for the exhibition but his schedule was completely booked until March 2019. However, there was an idea of exhibiting to him through the Uganda AIDS commission led programs.</p> <p>The Academy was requested to reach out to other development partners for more funding for the exhibition and share the concept with the them like PEPFAR.</p> <p>There was another idea of coming up with a list of relevant organizations that have visited and share with them the concept for the mobile exhibition for resource mobilization.</p> <p>Sylvia also suggested to make wardrobe kind of boards for the mobile exhibition and just travel with them.</p> <p>5. Update on permanent home at TASO and curation of collection materials – Sylvia Matovu/ Michael Etukoit.</p> <p>The place for the exhibition at TASO house of hope is not yet constructed, it will take approximately 18 months to be finished. It was noted that the materials will be taken to TASO Kanyanya. 

